For unlimited water taxi rides, adult \*one-day and two-day passes are also offered for \$31.00 and \$40.00 respectively.

- Water Taxi: One-way ticket prices quoted for Alexandria-The Wharf service; One-day and two-day passes are valid for unlimited water taxi rides on a single date or two consecutive days, as appropriate. T&Cs apply.
- Dining experiences include freshly prepared, multi-course plated menu with unlimited coffee, hot tea, iced tea and water. Brunch also includes bottomless mimosas. Some elements may change due to current restrictions. Dishes served covered with lids – removed at the table. Single-use menus will be provided and discarded (recycled) afterwards.
